## **QUALIFICATIONS FOR AD HOC 12 & 12 REVIEW COMMITTEE**

- 1) Seven years in the Fellowship;
- 2) Five years of service beyond the meeting level;
- 3) Attendance as a delegate to at least two World Service Business Conferences; and
- 4) Five years of continuous recovery in Overeaters Anonymous as evidenced by:
  - i) five years of current continuous abstinence;
  - ii) current maintenance of a healthy body weight for at least two years; and
  - iii) emotional and spiritual growth as a result of incorporating into their lives the Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions as a new way of living.
- 5) Worked through all Twelve Steps;
- 6) Declared themselves as practicing the Twelve Steps to the best of their ability;
- 7) Declared themselves as committed to the Twelve Traditions of Overeaters Anonymous; and
- 8) Affirmed these additional qualifications on their application form

Upon selection to the committee, each participant shall make a commitment of:

- 1) Adherence to the Twelve Steps, Twelve Traditions and Twelve Concepts of OA Service.
- 2) Continual recovery, including abstinence and maintenance of a healthy body weight throughout the entire term(s) of office. Each person shall be the judge of his or her recovery including abstinence and maintenance of a healthy body weight.

## **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS**

- 1) Applicants must have readily available Internet access
- 2) Applicants must be able to participate on a monthly group conference call meeting, and be available for these meetings on Saturday afternoon if you are based in the USA. International committee members will fit with these times.
- 3) Applicants must be able to commit to reading and responding to material at least one hour per week.
